STUDENT UNIFORM POLICY

Context

The Lakes Christian College holds clear expectations for student uniform and personal appearance as set out in this policy. The College uniform promotes a sense of identity and pride for the school and its students with a focus on:

- **Belonging:**
Uniforms identify students as belonging to the Lakes Christian College community.
- **Safety:**
Uniforms are designed to promote student safety when engaged in a range of activities and learning experiences.
- **Learning:**
Having a consistent uniform enables students to engage in learning, without the distraction and comparison of free dress.
- **Preparedness:**
Uniforms prepare students to meet dress code expectations for their future employment and enhances connection between the College and wider community.

Policy Statement

All students at The Lakes Christian College are required to wear full and correct uniform at all times when travelling to and from school, during the school day, and when representing the College at various events or competitions. Students should wear their uniform with pride, ensuring that it is well-fitted, clean, and worn in a respectful manner. Parents/Carers are asked to partner with the College by ensuring that their child/ren arrive at school prepared to meet the uniform and dress standard.

College staff monitor student uniform with the aim of supporting personal presentation and character development. Where students fail to meet the prescribed standards, consequences ranging from reminders to suspensions will be applied. Students who continually choose to not meet these requirements may be asked to remain at home until the standard is met.

Students are not permitted to wear an item that may constitute offence or distress to another student or staff member. The uniform must be an appropriate fit for modesty and suitability for an educational environment. Uniform items are The Lakes Christian College branded and are available from Midford Uniform Shop and second-hand uniforms can be purchased through the College office.

Please label all clothing clearly with the student's name.

Acceptable Sport Shoes



Not Acceptable



Acceptable shoes for boys and girls are constructed of sturdy material, provide adequate support and cover the upper section of the foot for protection.

They should be:

- black leather
- lace up school design
- heeled up to 35mm
- sports shoes must be shock absorbing gym shoes (i.e. no skate or canvas sport shoes)
- shoes must be regularly polished
- shoe laces must be tied at all times.

Jewellery

General Guideline

Girls & Boys

Minimum jewellery is permitted but will be monitored as to its suitability. All students are expected to abide by the following policy:

- A fine necklace may be worn, with or without attachments, under the blouse or shirt.
- Chokers, heavy chains, or large bead necklaces are not permitted.
- One fine bracelet and/or ring is permitted.
- Earrings are limited to studs or sleepers (up to 10mm) & only one in the lower lobe of each ear.
- Only clear studs/plugs can be worn in additional ear piercings. New piercings are not exempt from this policy.
- Nose piercings are not acceptable.
- No other body piercings or body art is acceptable.
- Medic-alert bracelets and neck chains may be worn where this is required for a medically approved reason.
- Students are permitted to wear a casual or sports watch that only functions as a watch. Smartwatches are considered a device and are not permitted at school without prior approval from the Principal.
- For safety reasons, High School students may be asked to remove their jewellery for sports lessons.

Please be aware that jewellery is worn "at own risk". The College accepts no responsibility for lost or damaged items.

Non-Compliance Policy

Students who wear jewellery that does not comply with this policy will be asked to remove it immediately and hand it in to the Office. It will be kept in a safe place until the student brings a note from home to the Principal guaranteeing that it will not be worn again.

Please note there is a 2 week transition period allowed in Term 2 and Term 4.

- No streaks or colours.
- Hair past shoulder length must be tied back.
- Ribbons or scrunchies in college colours only.
- No fancy clips.
- Styles must allow college hat to be worn.

- Make-up is not to be worn.
- No nail polish.
- No false nails.

- Winter: either white socks or grey tights can be worn; tights to be worn for formal occasions e.g. Photo Day.
- Dress length to be below knee.
- Uniform, shoes and hair to be clean and tidy.
- No chewing gum.

Please note there is a 2 week transition period allowed in Term 2 and Term 4.

- Streaks or colours must be similar to original hair colour.
- Hair past shoulder length must be completely tied back, including long fringes and strips of hair.
- Ribbons or scrunchies in college colours only.
- No fancy clips.
- Styles must allow college hat to be worn.

- No make-up, with the exception of a natural foundation with sunscreen.
- No nail polish.
- No false nails.
- No false eyelashes.

- Winter: either white socks or black tights can be worn; tights to be worn for formal occasions e.g. Photo Day.
- Skirt length must touch the floor when kneeling.
- Uniform, shoes and hair to be clean and tidy.
- No chewing gum.

HAIR

- No streaks or colours.
- Hair length to be short and tidy.
- Hair length not less than a No.2.
- Styles must allow college hat to be worn.

UNIFORM

- Uniform, shoes and hair to be clean and tidy.
- No chewing gum.

High School

Summer Uniform worn in Terms 1 & 4.

Winter Uniform worn in Terms 2 & 3.

Please note there is a 2 week transition period allowed in term 2 and term 4.

HAIR

- No streaks or colours.
- Hair length to be short and tidy.
- Hair length not less than a No.2.
- No facial hair permitted.
- Styles must allow college hat to be worn.

UNIFORM

- Uniform, shoes and hair to be clean and tidy.
- Winter shirts must be tucked in.
- Summer shirts may be left untucked.
- Ties must be worn in Terms 2 & 3 and at all excursions and special occasions.
- No chewing gum.
